My Dear Schultz.,

I notice to day cheques drawn on us to the extent of about Tcs.30,000.- were paid in to the Cement Co's credit with my old friends the Hongkong Bank, no payments having been made to us since 11th May last.

I only take the liberty of drawing your kind attention to this as Phya Boribun informed me that the Hongkong Bank and ourselves were supposed to divide the honours, and I should not like you to think we were indifferent to the actions of such a good client as yourselves.

No doubt the Hongkong Bank are your principal Bankers as you pay your dividends etc. through them etc. etc; but we should appreciate it, if, in the meantime, cheques drawn on us could be paid in to the Company's credit in our books.

I am sure you will not construe this as an attempt to take away any business which you find more suitable to place elsewhere; and I hope you will excuse me for raising the above point in view of Phya Boribun's statement to me.
