Dear Sir,

We have forwarded to our London Office a copy of your letter of date instructing London to sell your securities as soon as they are free and to credit the Royal Siamese Treasury with £30,000 (Thirty Thousand Pounds Sterling). London will then send us a statement of your account.

With regard to exchange regulations, you are free to spend unfrozen funds anywhere in the Sterling Area. For transfer to a non-Sterling Area, permission will have to be obtained from the British Exchange Control who will require to know the reason for the transfer.

We have duly advised the Royal Siamese Treasury, Bangkok of the £30,000 to be credited to their account with our London Office.
