With reference to our letter of 1st November, regarding remittances from Bangkok to Denmark for the benefit of the families of your Company, we have now received a further advice from our London Office as follows:-

" The Bank of England inform us, that they are prepared to give favourable consideration to transfer of funds from a Siamese Account to a Danish Account for this purpose.

As each draft drawn by you in this connection will have to be the subject of a separate application, we shall be glad if you will give the fullest details possible on the relative schedule."

With reference to the last paragraph of their advice, we shall be obliged if in future you will give us the following information when making a remittance,

- 1) Purpose of remittance.
- 2) Number of persons who will benefit from the remittance.
